ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY: A student cannot be failing any subject any week of the season and be eligible to participate. If a student is failing any subject on the report card they will not be eligible for a two week period. (Dates will be determined by the Athletic Director)

ELIGIBILITY WEEK: Eligibility is determined on Monday from the prior weeks work. Teachers return eligibility sheets no later than on Monday to the Athletic Director. Coaches or Sponsors will inform students of eligibility status at Monday's practice. The period of eligibility is Tuesday through Monday.

ATTENDANCE: A student must be present for the last 4 periods of the school day in order to participate in an athletic event on that same day. In the case of a Saturday game/meet, the student needs to be in attendance the previous Friday for the last 4 periods. A student that is absent from practices can be excluded from participation.

CONDUCT: A student who has displayed unsatisfactory conduct at school, sporting events or practice can be ineligible for participation as determined by the coach/sponsor or school administration.

INELIGIBILITY MEANS: The student will not:

- -Ride team bus to away games/meets or represent the school at related events.
- -Participate in practice (optional; based on reason for ineligibility status)
- -Wear a uniform

EXCEPTIONS: Special exceptions can be granted by a Building Administrator or the Superintendent.

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

When traveling to away games all students must ride the team bus. Students may go home from the event with their parents/guardian. Due to liability issues students are NOT permitted to go home with other student's parents or friends, under any circumstances. Students are expected to notify their coach before leaving with their parents. When the students return to Yorkville Middle School, they may go home with others according to their parent's instruction.
